

Dog Grooming

101



Daily:



Wipe feet

after long walks or outdoor play sessions.

Brush

your dogs coat – this is especially important for long-haired dogs who may get tangled or matted fur.



Weekly:



Teeth cleaning

- Pet-approved toothpaste and dental treats are recommended here.

Monthly:

Bathing

- Can be done at home or at the groomers.
- Use pet approved shampoo, and make sure the water is not too hot or cold.



Every 2-3 months:

These can be done at home or at the groomers.

Nail trim

- If done at home, choose appropriate tools, such as nail clippers or dog nail file.



Haircut

- Every few months for long or curly hair dogs.
- Short hair dogs require less maintenance.
- Consistent haircuts can help make brushing and bathing simpler.
